Meritorious Full Time candidates will receive Nitte (Deemed to be University) PhD Fellowships of Rs. 15,000/- per month as per University guidelines. External Part Time candidates shall be permitted to register for Ph.D, subject to the recognition by Nitte (Deemed to be University) of his/her parent Institution as a Centre of Ph.D studies.

The last date for online application is **20-07-2020**. Details of online examination process and admission ticket will be sent to eligible candidates. For details such as Regulations, Statement of Purpose and approved list of Ph.D Guides please refer the website www.nitte.edu.in.

An **Online Entrance Test** (40 MCQs of 1 mark each from the basics of the faculty selected in application and 20 MCQs of 1 mark each on Research aptitude) of 60 minutes duration will be held on **10-08-2020** and an interview/presentation will be held thorough video conferencing . The detailed schedule of the Interview will be published on the website after the entrance exam. Applications of candidates who appear for entrance test and online interview alone will be considered for selection. The final selection will be based on the Written test, Interview and Statement of Purpose. Inter se merit lists prepared for each faculty will form the basis for award of the NU PhD Fellowships. Candidates who do not qualify for the Fellowship but otherwise meet the admission requirements (Candidate has to score overall, a minimum of 50% to be eligible for admission) will also be offered admission sans the fellowship.
